

Quick start to current programmes accessible to sports and community organisations

Programmes are open to not for profit organisations.

Facilities

Sports Facilities Fund

The provision or upgrading of all formal sports facilities for the general community.

Large project strand

- Total project value above £100k (inc VAT)
- All applicants are eligible to apply for up to a maximum of 50% funding.

Small project strand

- Total project value between £10,000 and £100,000 (inc. VAT)
- All applicants are eligible to apply for up to a maximum of 50% funding.
- In exceptional circumstances club led projects with a total project value of between £10,000 and £50,000 (inc. VAT) are eligible to apply for up to a maximum of 100% funding

Legacy 2014 Active Places

- To create facilities which encourage more people to be active and take part in informal sport.
- All applicants are eligible to apply for up to a maximum of 50% funding.
- Deadlines 1st July 2014, 1st February 2015

UKCC subsidy for coaches

- Funding for accessible, affordable coaching courses
- UKCC endorsed qualifications
- Award level up to 50% or £150 of the course fee whatever is lower at level 1
- Direct subsidy to SGB for level 2 (50% or £420) and level 3 (75% or £800)
- Applications no later than 4 weeks prior to course start date

Direct club investment programme

This programme is focused on strengthening club sport by investing in sport clubs that can significantly deliver on:

- Growth in club membership and/or;

Award level: A guide figure of up to £10,000 per project per annum. Investment will be provided for 2-4 years, depending on the project
